

## DRESS CODE

It should be noted that it is the request of most parents that their children wear a uniform or have a dress code, and that it is part of our school policy and procedures to use a uniform dress code. Both parents and students are responsible for seeing to it that the dress code is followed. Students are responsible for their conduct at school and at school related activities. Every family will be expected to conform to the dress code requirement.

**We believe that Christian modesty, self-respect, cleanliness and safety are required for in school and out of school events. Any clothing or apparel that is visible is subject to the dress code.**

In addition, a used uniform sale is held near the end of the school year.

**School Clothes must be from the Uniform Place, or must match so closely that they appear to be the same.**

### Boys and Girls:

*Slacks:* Plain solid navy blue uniform dress pants. Twill or corduroy. No tight-fitting slacks.

*Sweaters:* Cardigan , V-Neck, Crew Neck or Vest  
Solid red, white or navy. A collared shirt must be worn underneath.  
No hooded sweaters.

*Sweatshirt:* St. John's uniform sweatshirt only. Collared shirt must be worn underneath.

*Shoes:* Black, brown or navy dress or athletic shoes (closed toe and closed heel).  
Athletic shoes may not have a logo on the outside of the shoe. For safety on stairways be certain that the soles are soft rubber. Shoes should tie or be secured in a way that they will not easily slip off.

*Shorts:* Shorts **are not permitted** as part of the uniform dress code.

*Hair:* No hair coloring. Boys' hair cuts must be no longer than touching the shirt collar and trimmed away from the eyes.

### Boys:

*Shirts:* Solid white or red polo shirt, regular dress shirt, or turtleneck.

*Socks:* Solid white, navy or black. Socks must be worn.

\*It is suggested that boys in grades 5-8 wear a plain brown or black belt with slacks.

**Girls:**

*Jumper:* For Grades K4 through 4  
Red and blue plaid

*Skirt:* For Grades 5 through 8  
Red and blue plaid, pleated

*Blouse/Shirt:* Plain solid white or red uniform blouse, polo style shirt (knit shirt with a collar and 3 or 4 buttons at neck), or turtleneck style. No lace or ruffled styles.

*Socks/Tights:* Solid red, white or navy. Socks or tights must be worn at all times.

*Jewelry, Nail Polish, Make-up:* A watch, small pendant on a neck chain or a ring are acceptable pieces of jewelry. Nail polish and make-up are not permitted. Teachers and the principal will continually monitor this, and may ask students to remove make-up, nail polish, or excessive jewelry. Parents will be notified of repeat offenses.

**Gym Attire:**

*Grades K4-4:* Tennis shoes are required for gym class. Shoes should be brought to school on gym days or a pair may be kept in the classroom.

*Grades 5-8:* A t-shirt or sweatshirt and shorts or sweat pants are required for gym class. Students use the locker rooms to change before and after class. Athletic shoes are also required. No phone calls will be made for forgotten gym attire. Inappropriate words or pictures on clothing will not be permitted.

No tight or revealing shorts or shirts are permitted.

**NOT ALLOWED:** TANK TOPS, SPAGHETTI STRAPS, MINI SKIRTS OR DRESSES, PANTS THAT ARE EXCESSIVELY BAGGY OR TIGHT, TOPS THAT DO NOT COVER THE MIDRIFF WHEN ARMS ARE LIFTED OVERHEAD, NECKLINES THAT ARE REVEALING. THIS APPLIES TO IN-SCHOOL AND SCHOOL SPONSORED EVENTS.

Jewelry and other personal property is not required and is brought at a student's own risk.
